

Always use precision BB Bullets for this air gun. Never use any used BBs



Do not look directly into the gun barrel to avoid accidental discharge of BB.



Never aim or shoot a person or animal as the target. Always set the selector on safety position except when you are ready to shoot a target.



Never hold the gun sideways as the BB bullets will curve right or left. This is due to the HOP-UP system.



Do not brandish in public, do not alter the coloration and markings, such an action is dangerous and may be a crime.



Select a safe place for operating the air gun, avoiding places where people and cars pass cross or third persons are around.



Always remove the battery and store the air gun in a case or bag and at a place out of reach by children so that they will not be injured during mischevous play.





Disassembling or modifying the gun may generate danger or adversely affect the performance, so avoid disassembling or modifying the air gun.




There are cases that bullets remain in the gun after the magazine is disconnected, pulling the trigger carelessly is extremely dangerous. After towards a safe direction and fire to confirm that no bullets remain in the gun.

1 COMPONENTS







Do not switch the selector lever when the trigger is pulled. Do not pull the trigger when switching the selector. Damage and malfunction will occur if you attempt to do so.




2.Semi-Auto Airsoft gun fires a single BB with each pull of the trigger.




1. Safety Setting Please set the selector lever to safe when not using the gun.




3.Full-Auto The airsoft gun will fire continously while the trigger remains pulled.




- 1.Remove the Flash Hider.
- 2. Unscrew the screw on the Handguard, then remove the Handguard.

- 2. Unscrew the screw under the handstop.




QD mount for sling or other accessories with QD mount.

- 3. Magazine capacity: 180rds


5 TELESCOPIC STOCK

- 1. Pull the stock backward directly to extend, there are three positions to choose from.
- 2. Press the stock telescopic button, simultaneously push stock forward to retract the stock.




6 BATTERY INSTALLATION


- 1. Press the telescopic button and stock release button at the same time to revove the stock.
- 2. Flip downward the battery compartment cover, then connect the battery.
- 3. Insert the battery to the compartment.



7 HOP-UP ADJUSTMENT --





- 1. Pull the charging handle backward to reveal the Hop-up unit.
- 2.Adjust the hop-up knob to the desired position, the best position is where the bbs fly horizontally and longest distance is obtained.



8 MAINTENANCE


- 8-1 Maintenance when bullet speed becomes low
- 1. Apply oil as shown below, using the cleaning rod and oiled cotton cloth, insert cleaning rod into the barrel.
- 2. To complete the cleaning, use the cleaning rod (with cotton) as shown below to remove excess oil.






Warning

Always carry out maintenance AFTER returning the hop up knob to the default position. (Hop-OFF)




Hold at the leading end of the rod and insert the rod into the barrel while turning the rod.



Length: Approx 25 to 30mm Width: Approx.10mm



Wind the cut cotton cloth.



8-2 Routine Maintenance



Inserting the rod will be difficult if you hold rop at the end.

- 1. Keep the rifle in clean condition.
- 2. Never used dirty, damaged or distorted bullets.
- 3. Regularly clean the barrel with soft cleaning rod.
